

Instructions about Abstract:

The participants must submit the abstract (within 300 words) through online system related to theme based on original research work, systematic reviews, case studies typed in Times New Roman, font size 12 with 1.5 spacing. The Abstract should include: Title, Names and Affiliations of the Authors (the name of the presenting author should be underlined), brief introduction, methodology, results followed by a crisp conclusion.
